Footnote. General dentists (GDs) represent about 74% of the DPBRN network members. Specialists (SPs) included in this survey are represented by six subcategories encompassing dentistry domains such as endodontics, periodontics, prosthodontics, orthodontics, pediatric dentistry, dental public health, and oral and maxillofacial surgery. 'Other' corresponds to SP categories not pertaining to the present study (<http://nationaldentalpbrn.org/>), so that 992 SPs were considered for this study.
