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Table 3. Types of problem presentation solicit

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Problem presentation solicit
<b>Requests for description of problems/expectations</b> ("How can I help?" "What seems to be the problem?")
<b>Seizure description invitations</b> ("What happens?" "Describe these attacks")
<b>Closed seizure questions</b> (not followed by a seizure description invitation "When did they start?")
<b>Addresses third party</b>
<b>Missing</b> (the doctor does not issue a problem presentation solicit – instead the opening phase is followed by a structured history-taking phase and the patient has no opportunity to present their problem more freely)

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
