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


Figure 1: A and B show T1w and fat saturated T2w sagittal images. Short white arrow shows the second tarsometatarsal joint, scored as a grade 2 (partial thickness or focal loss) for joint space narrowing (JSN), grade 2 (moderate) osteophyte, the presence of effusion/synovitis, the presence of cysts, grade 2 (34%-66%) bone marrow lesion (BML) at the intermediate cuneiform and grade 1 (1%-33%) in the base of the second metatarsal. The second metatarsophalangeal joint was scored as a grade 2 for JSN, grade 2 osteophytes, in addition to grade 1 BML at the head of the second metatarsal.
