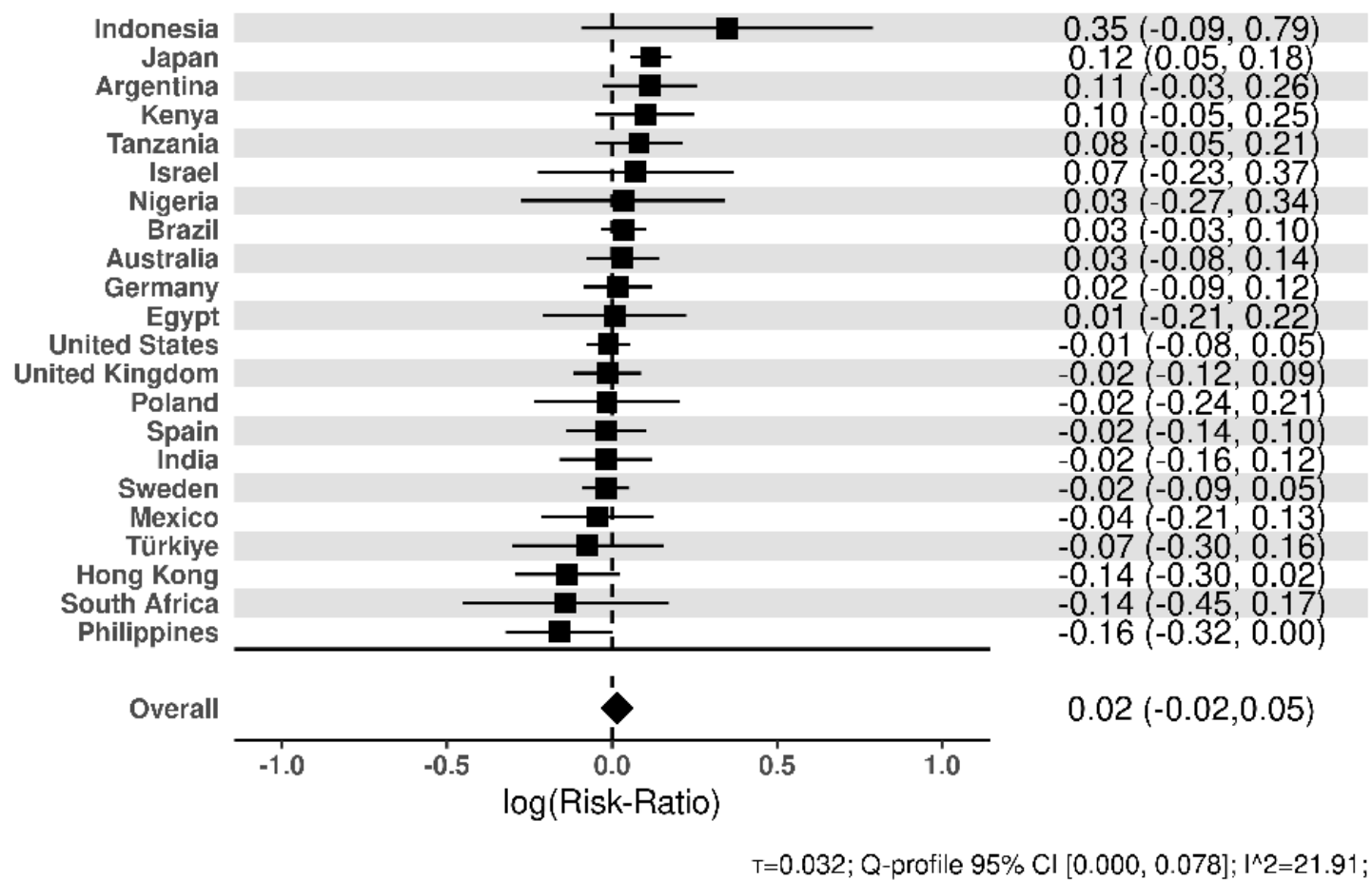


Figure S2. Forest plot for `Relationship with father` - `Very good/somewhat good` effect

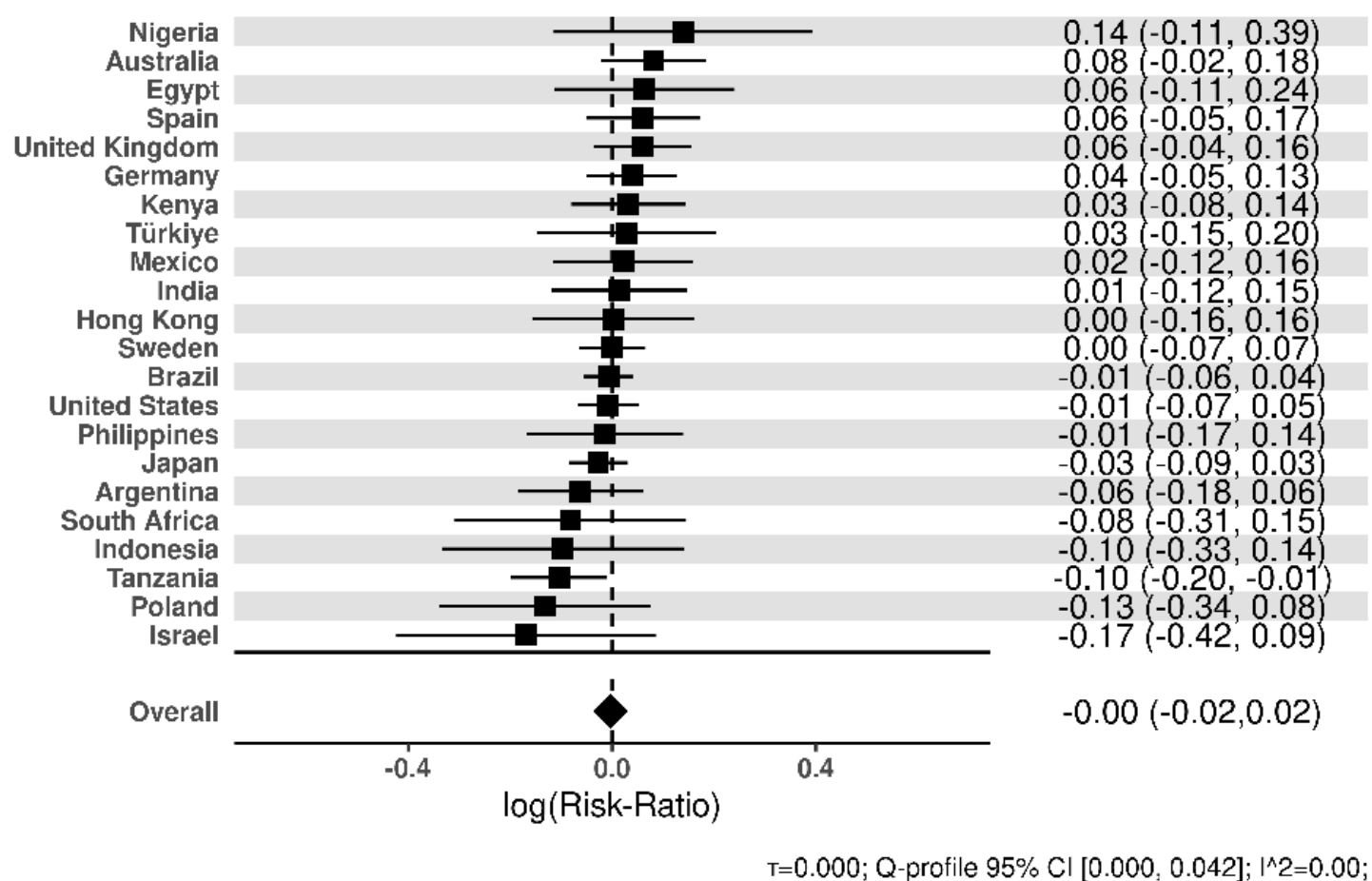
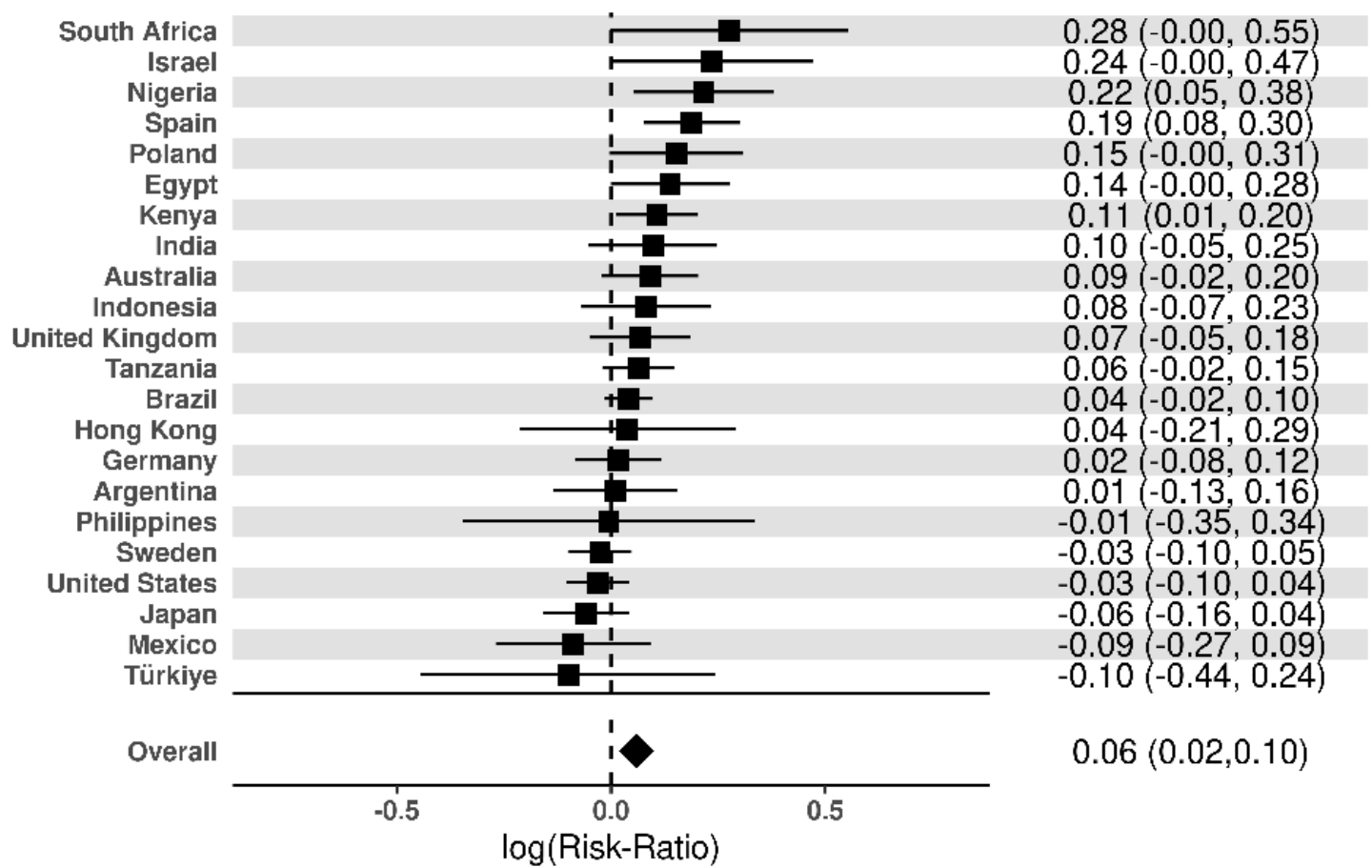


Figure S3. Forest plot for `Parent marital status`-`No, divorced` effect

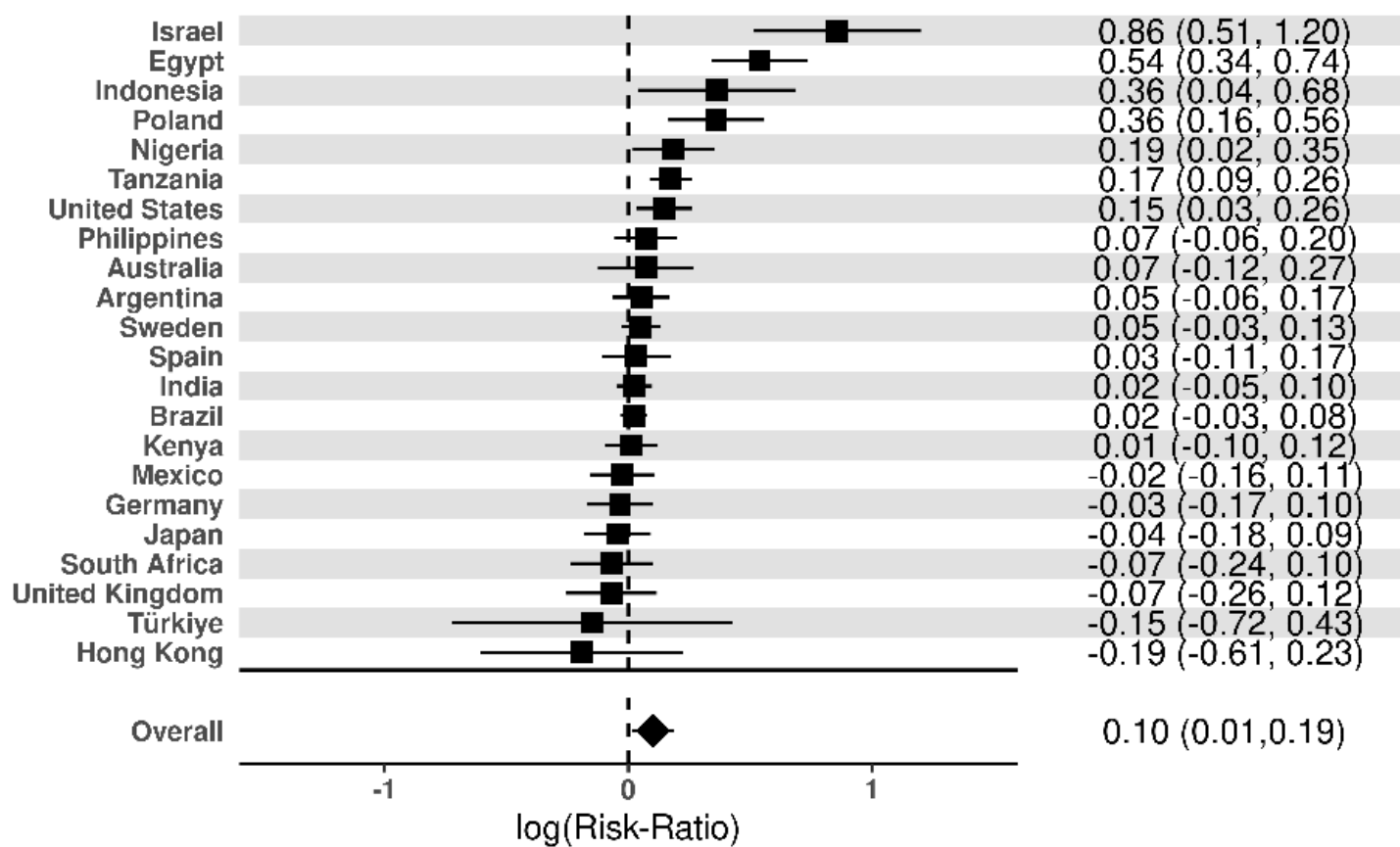

Figure S4. Forest plot for `Parent marital status`-`Single, never married` effect

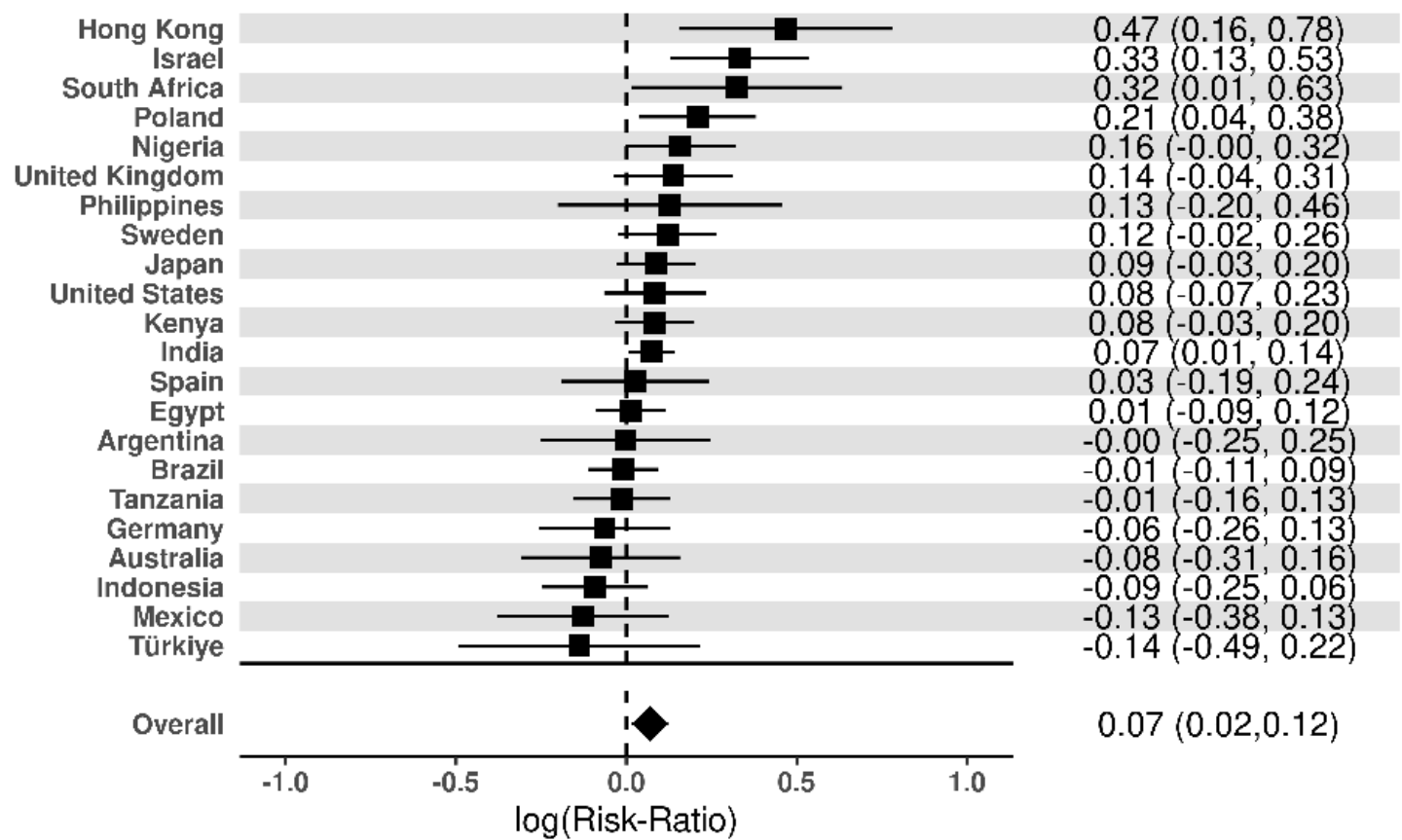

Figure S5. Forest plot for `Parent marital status`-`No, one or both of them had died` effect

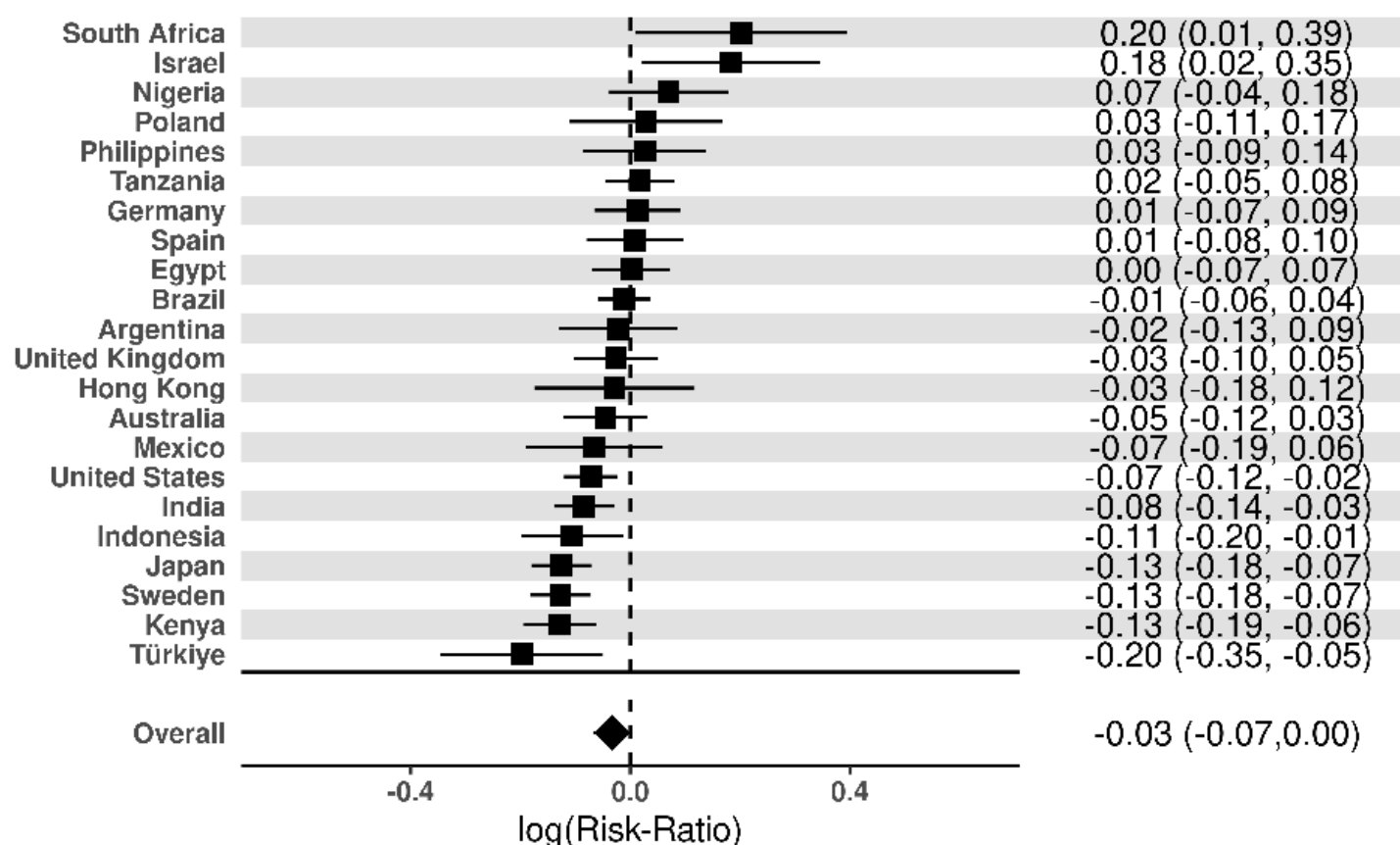

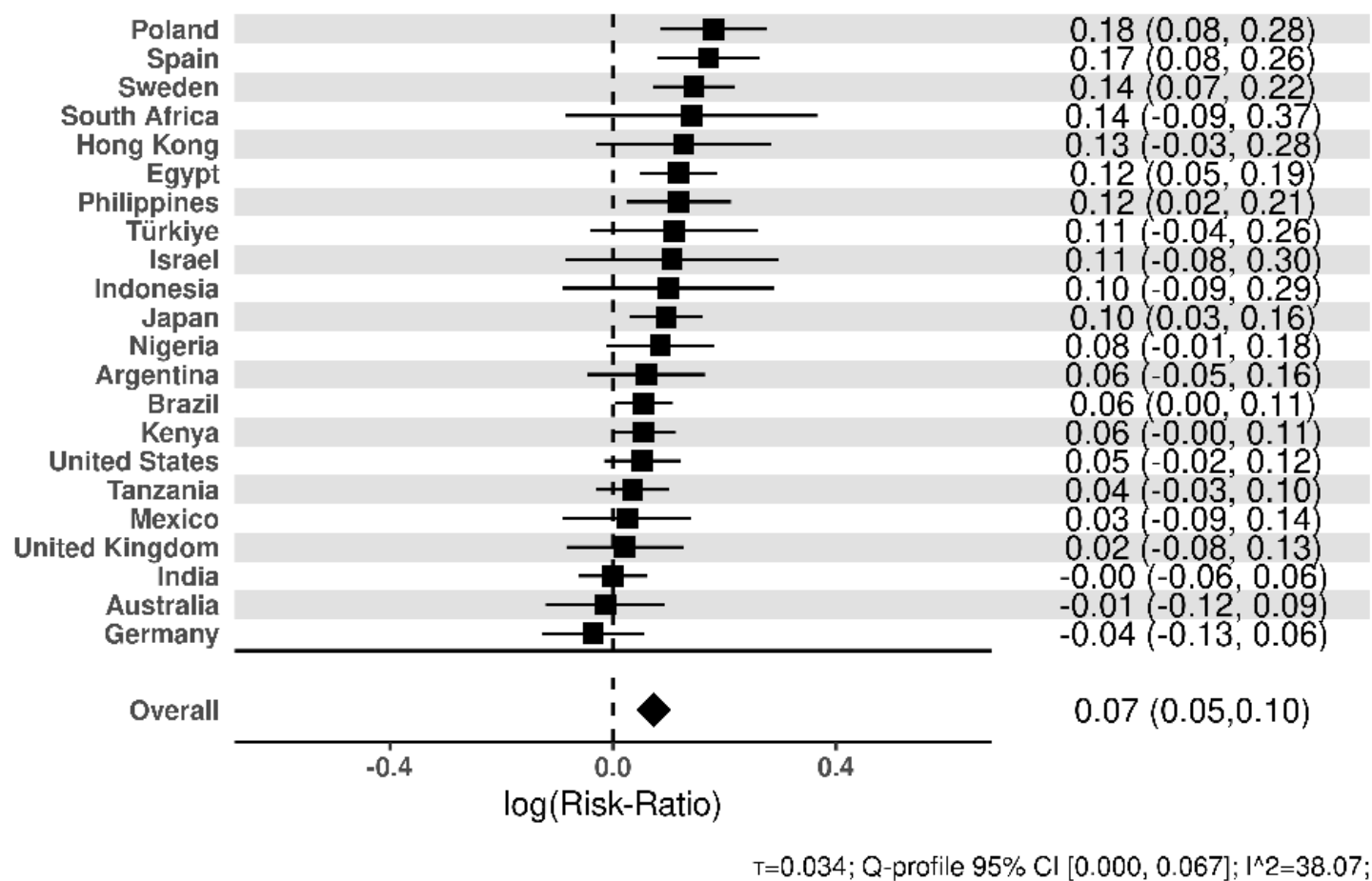


Figure S8. Forest plot for `Subjective financial status of family growing up`-`Found it very difficult` effect

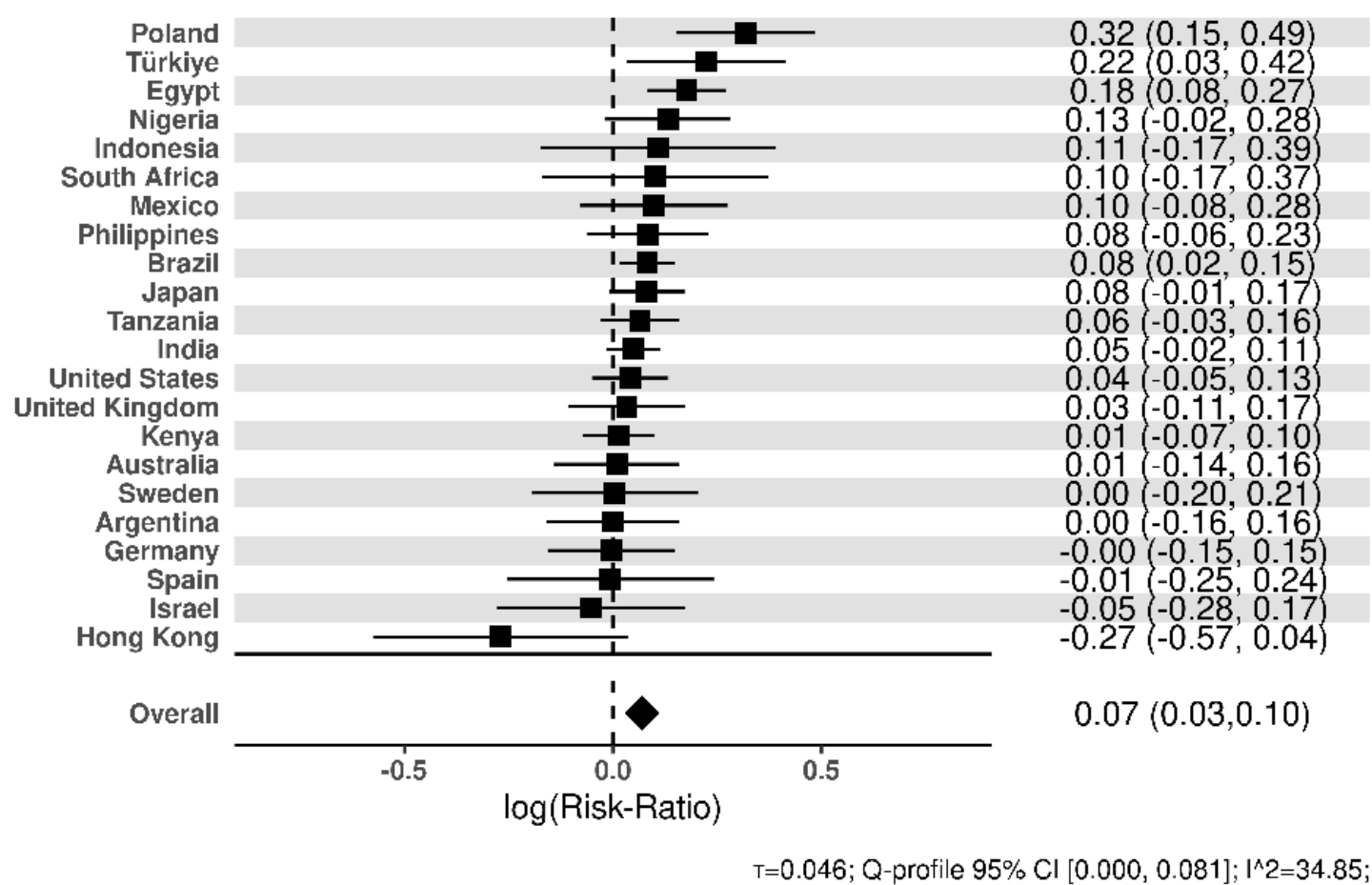


Figure S9. Forest plot for `Abuse`-`Yes` effect

Abuse (Ref: No)

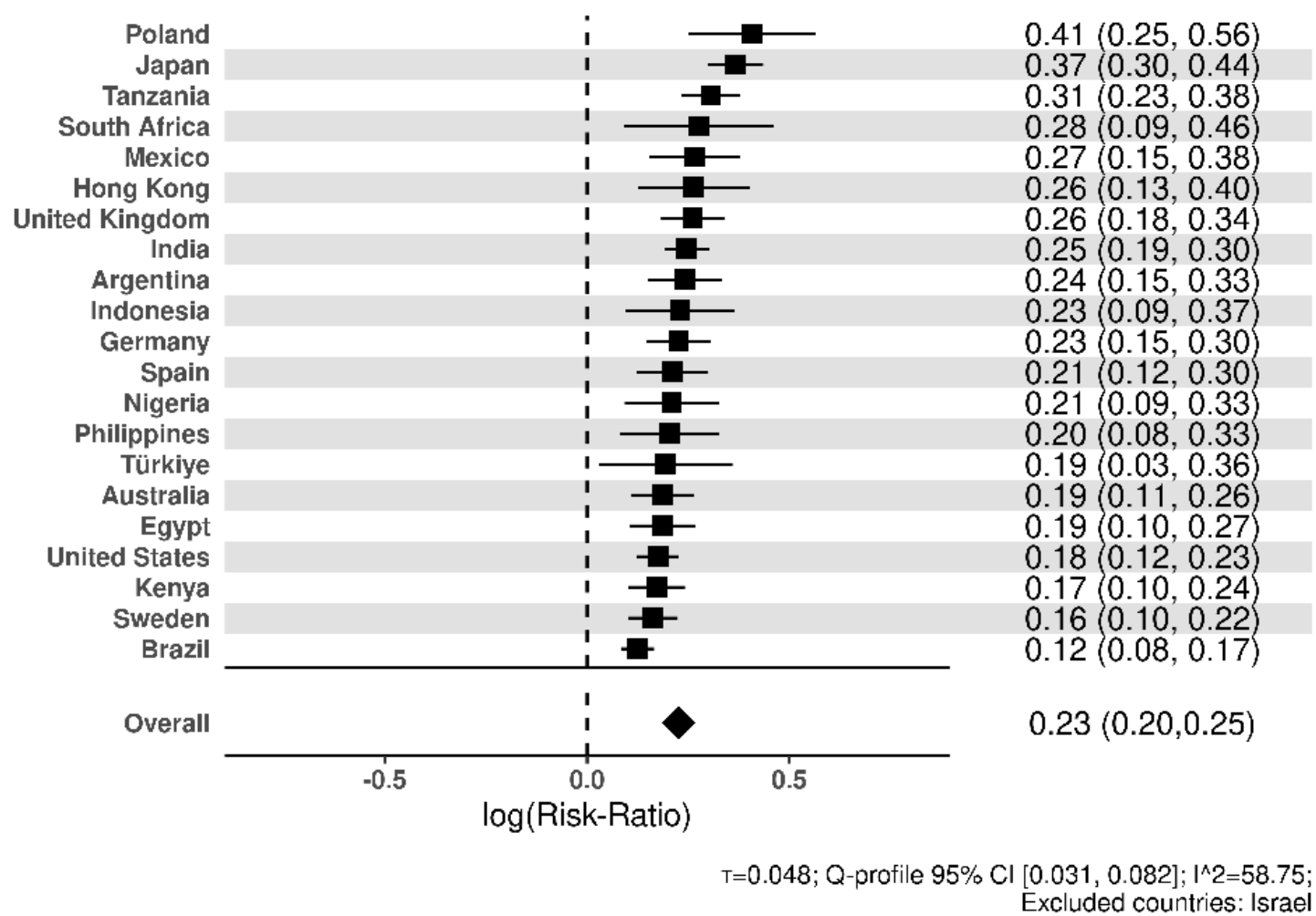


Figure S10. Forest plot for `Outsider growing up`-`Yes` effect

Outsider growing up (Ref: No)

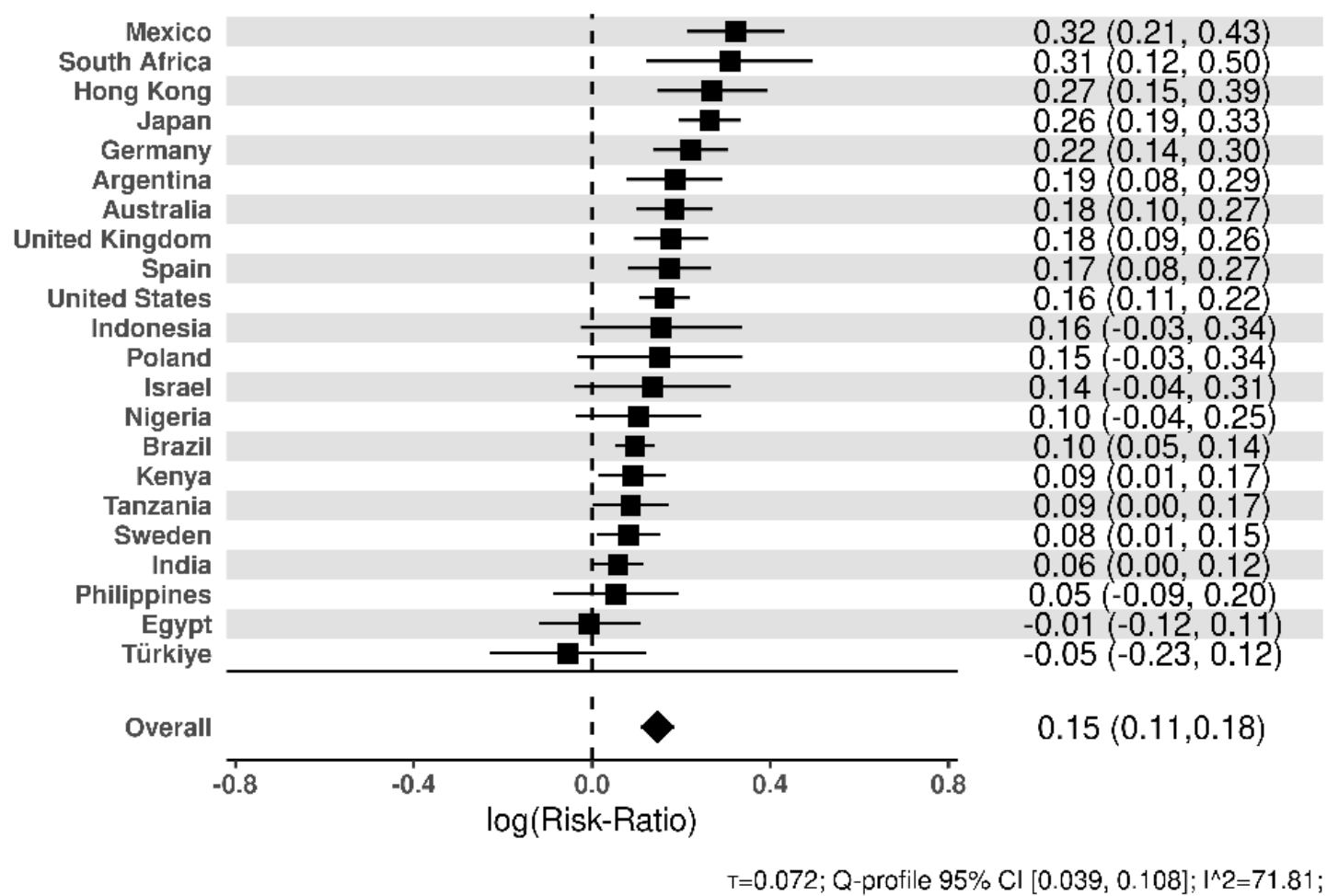


Figure S11. Forest plot for `Self-rated health growing up` - `Excellent` effect

Self-rated health growing up (Ref: Good)

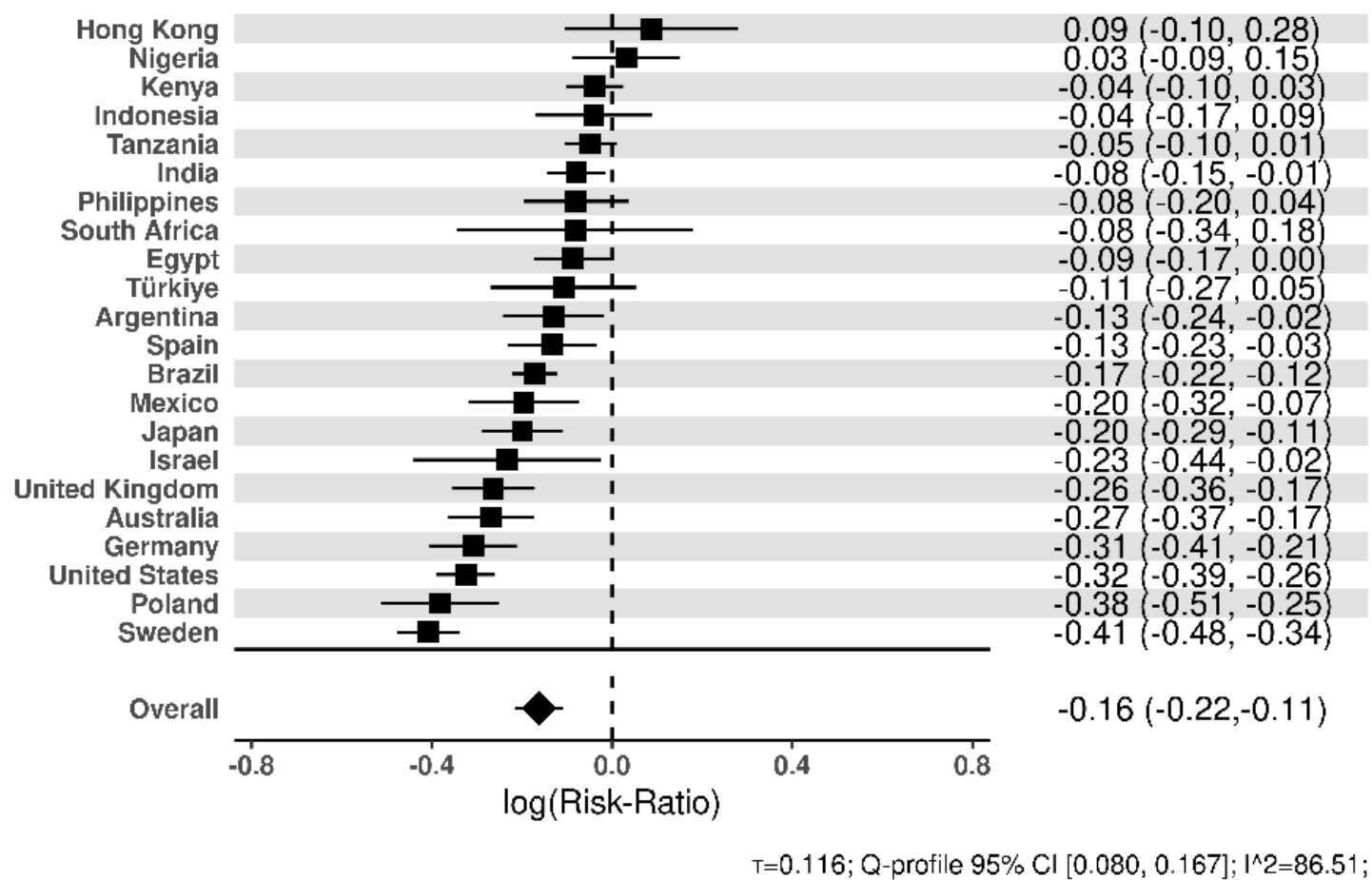


Figure S12. Forest plot for `Self-rated health growing up` - `Very good` effect

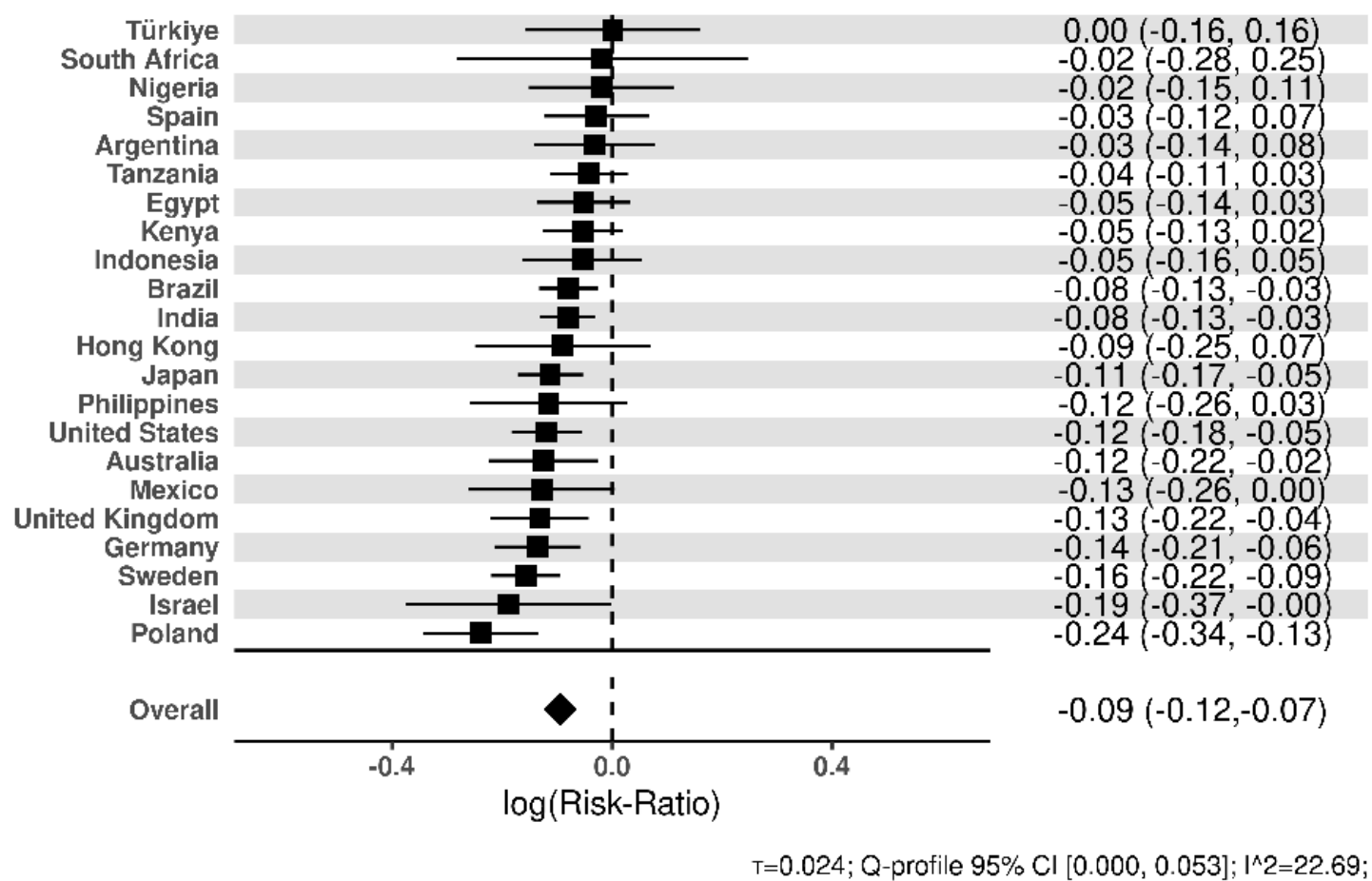


Figure S13. Forest plot for `Self-rated health growing up` - `Fair` effect

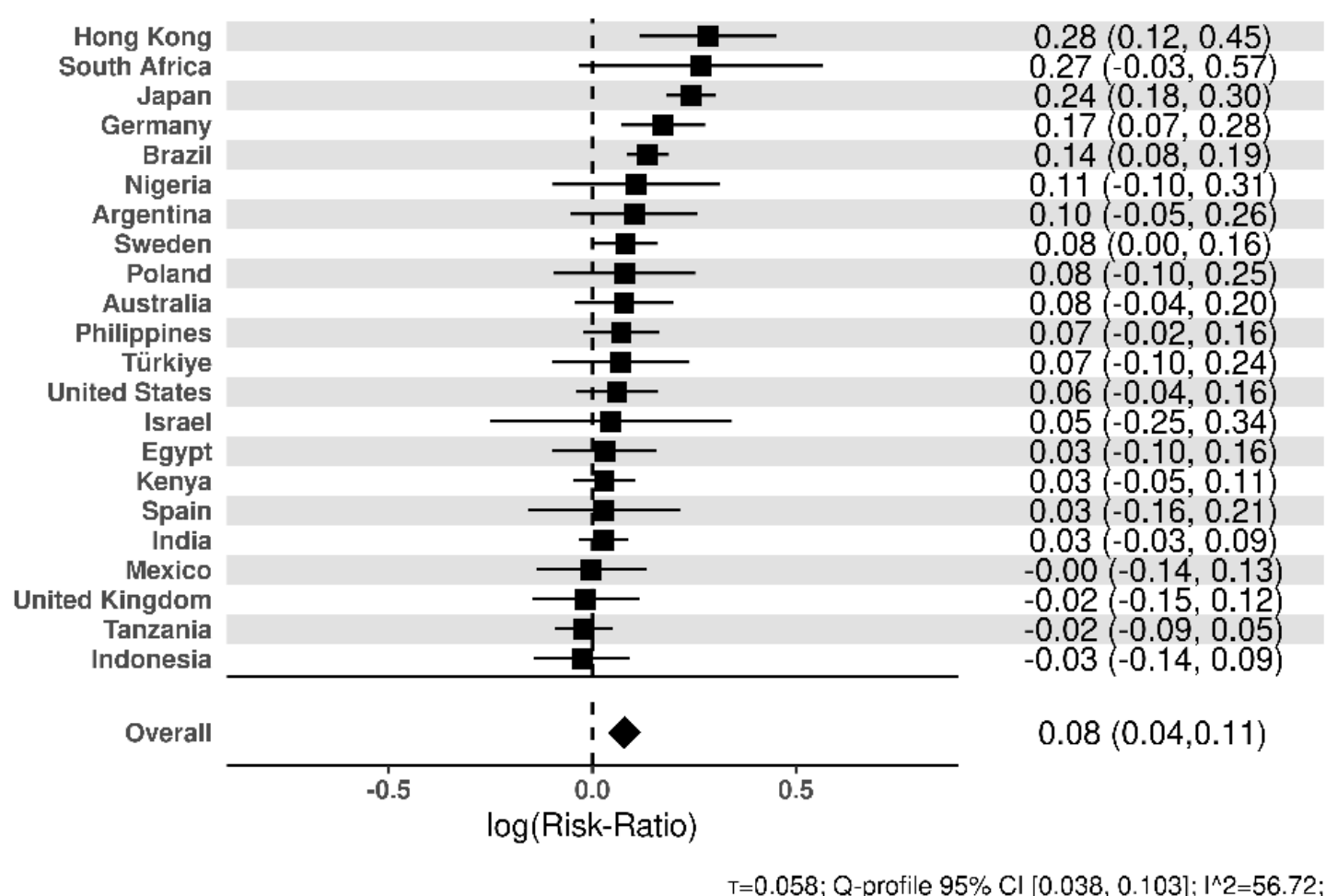


Figure S14. Forest plot for `Self-rated health growing up` - `Poor` effect

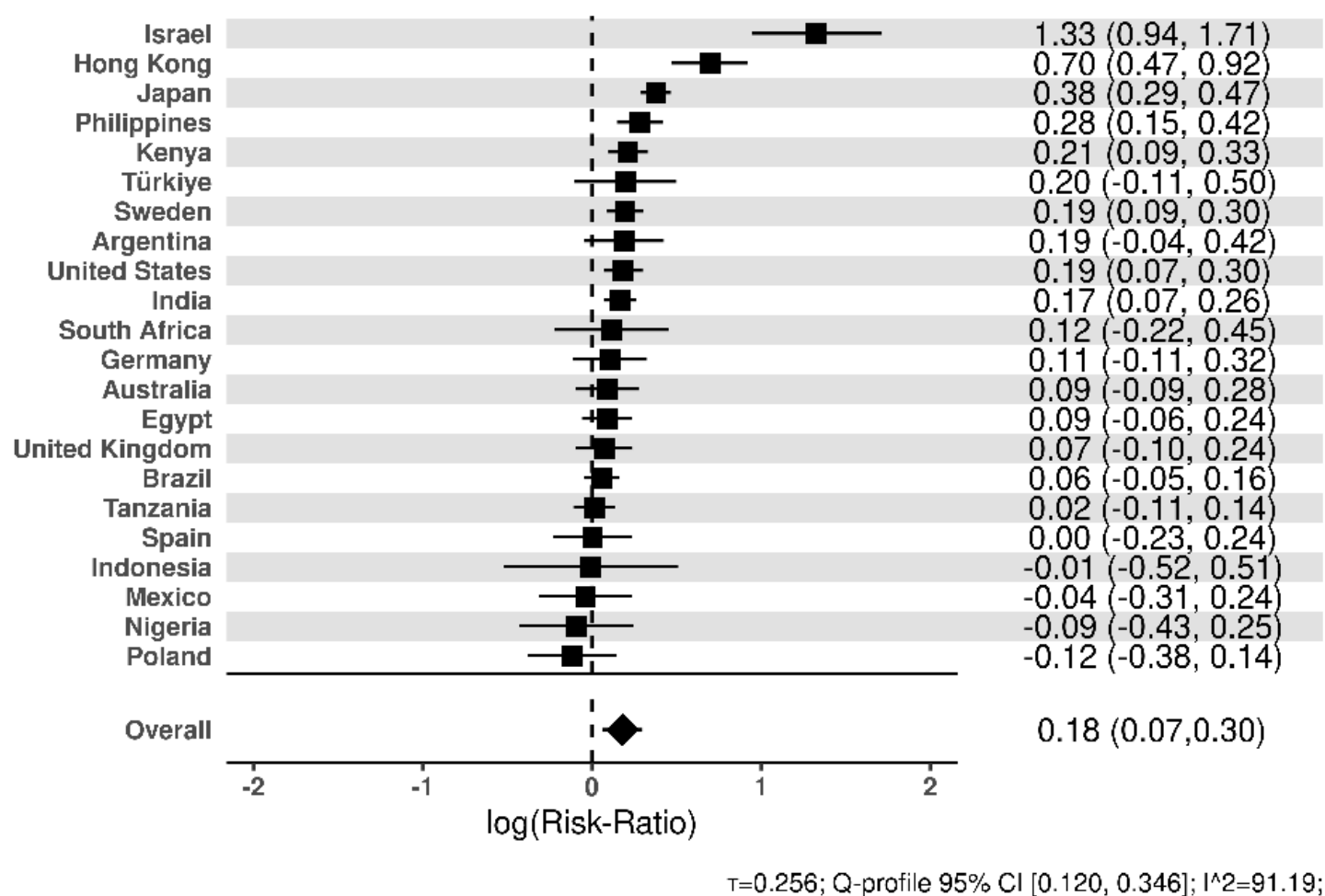
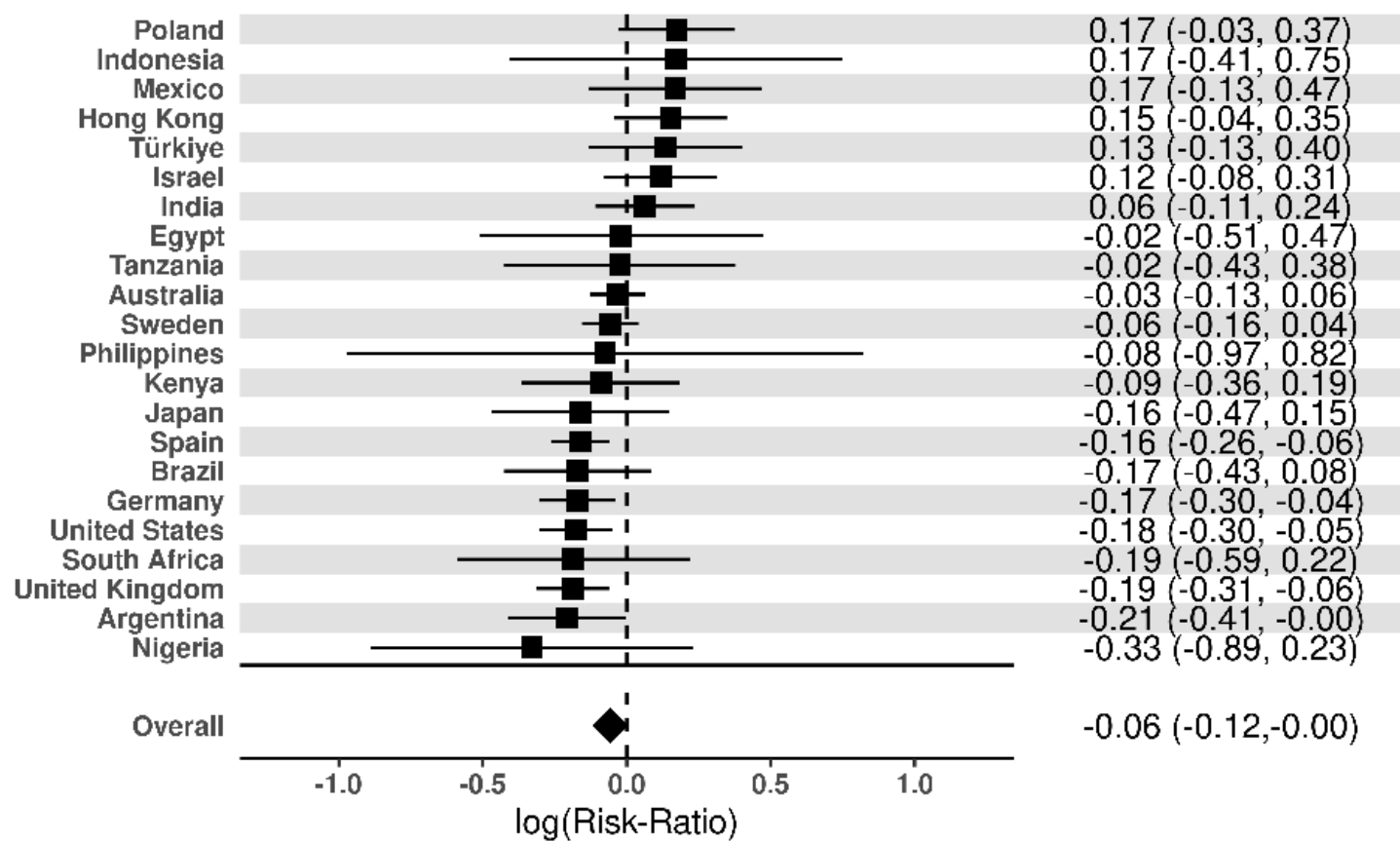


Figure S15. Forest plot for `Immigration status`-`Born in another country` effect

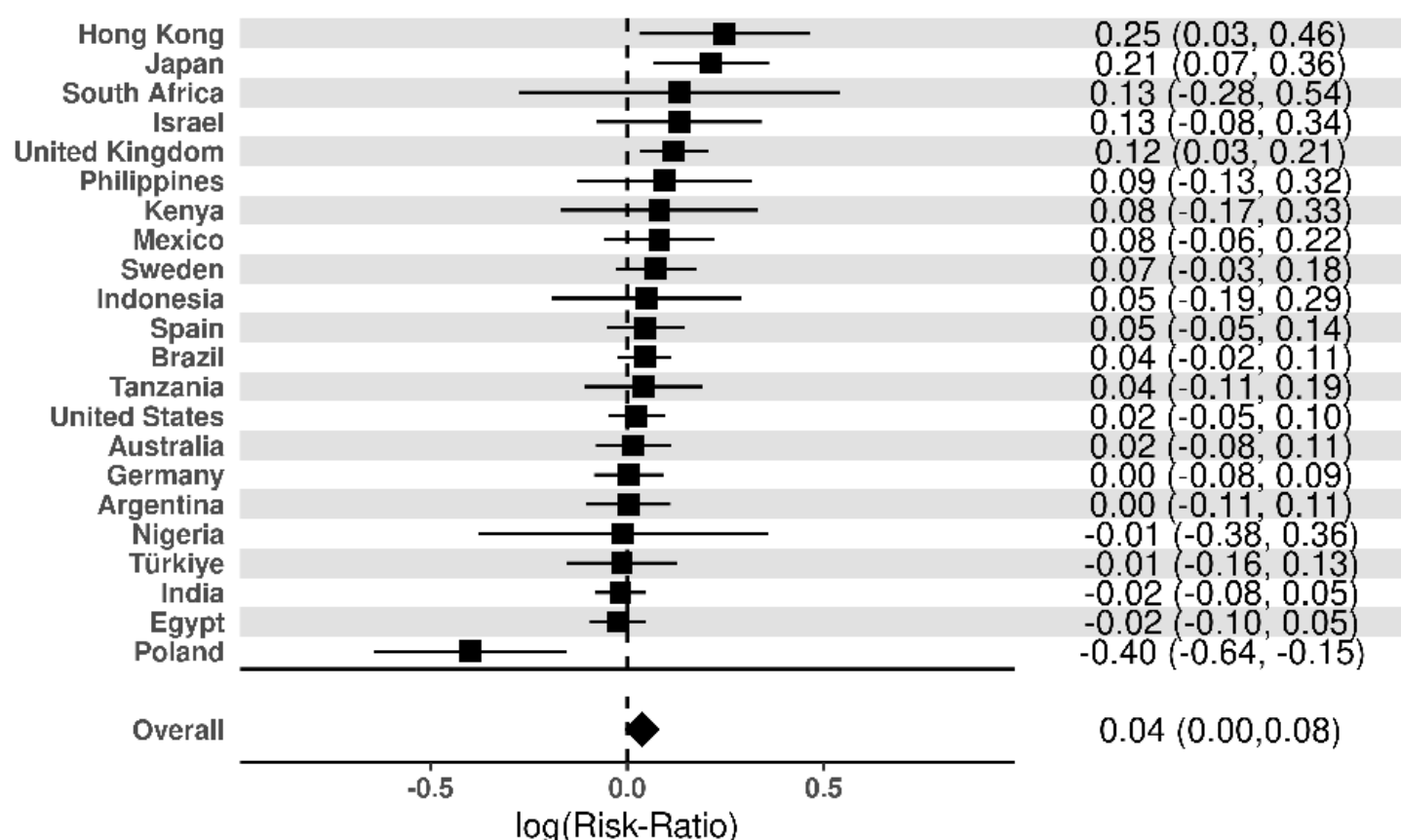

Figure S16. Forest plot for `Age 12 religious service attendance`-`At least 1/week` effect

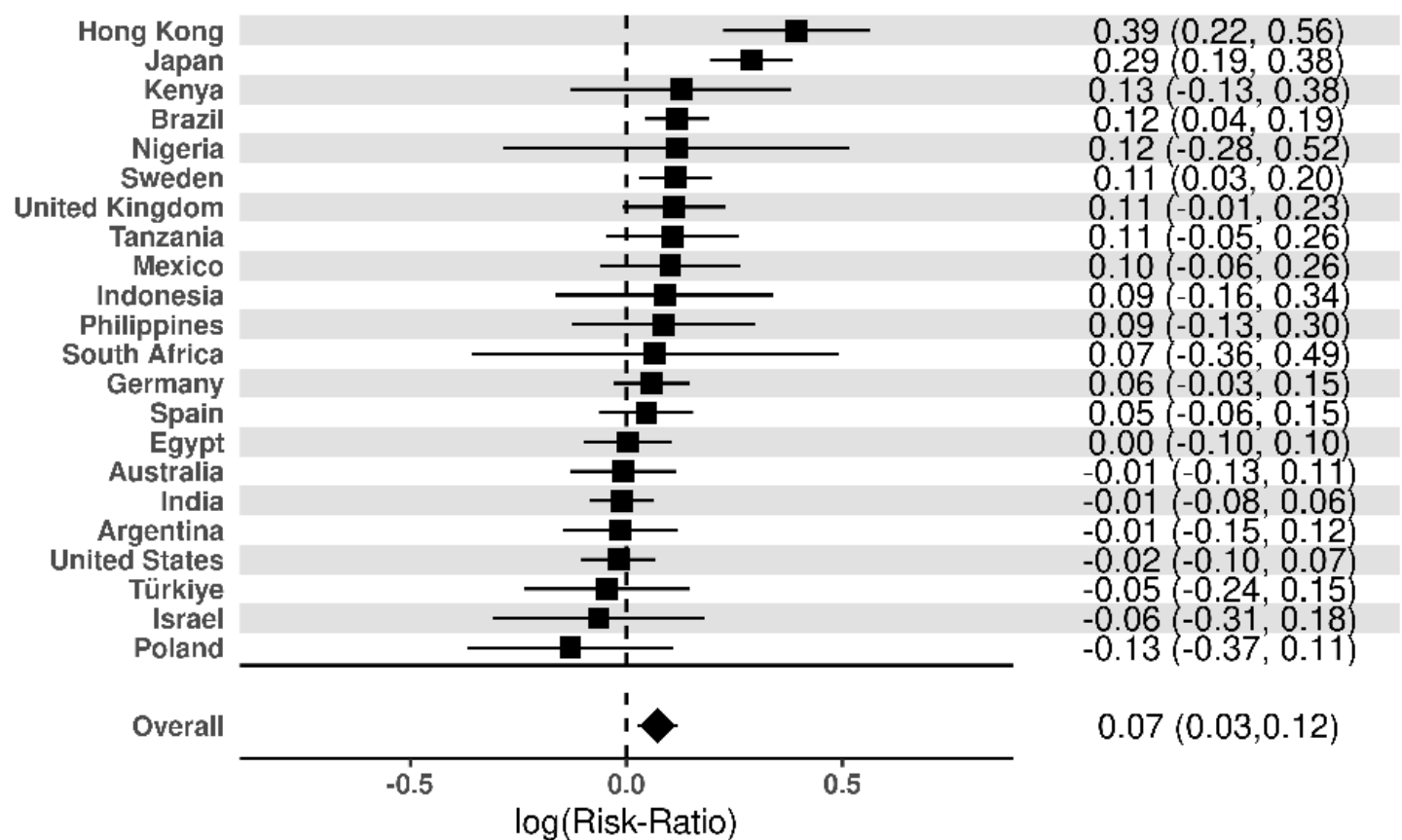
Age 12 religious service attendance (Ref: Never)

Figure S17. Forest plot for `Age 12 religious service attendance`-`1-3/month` effect

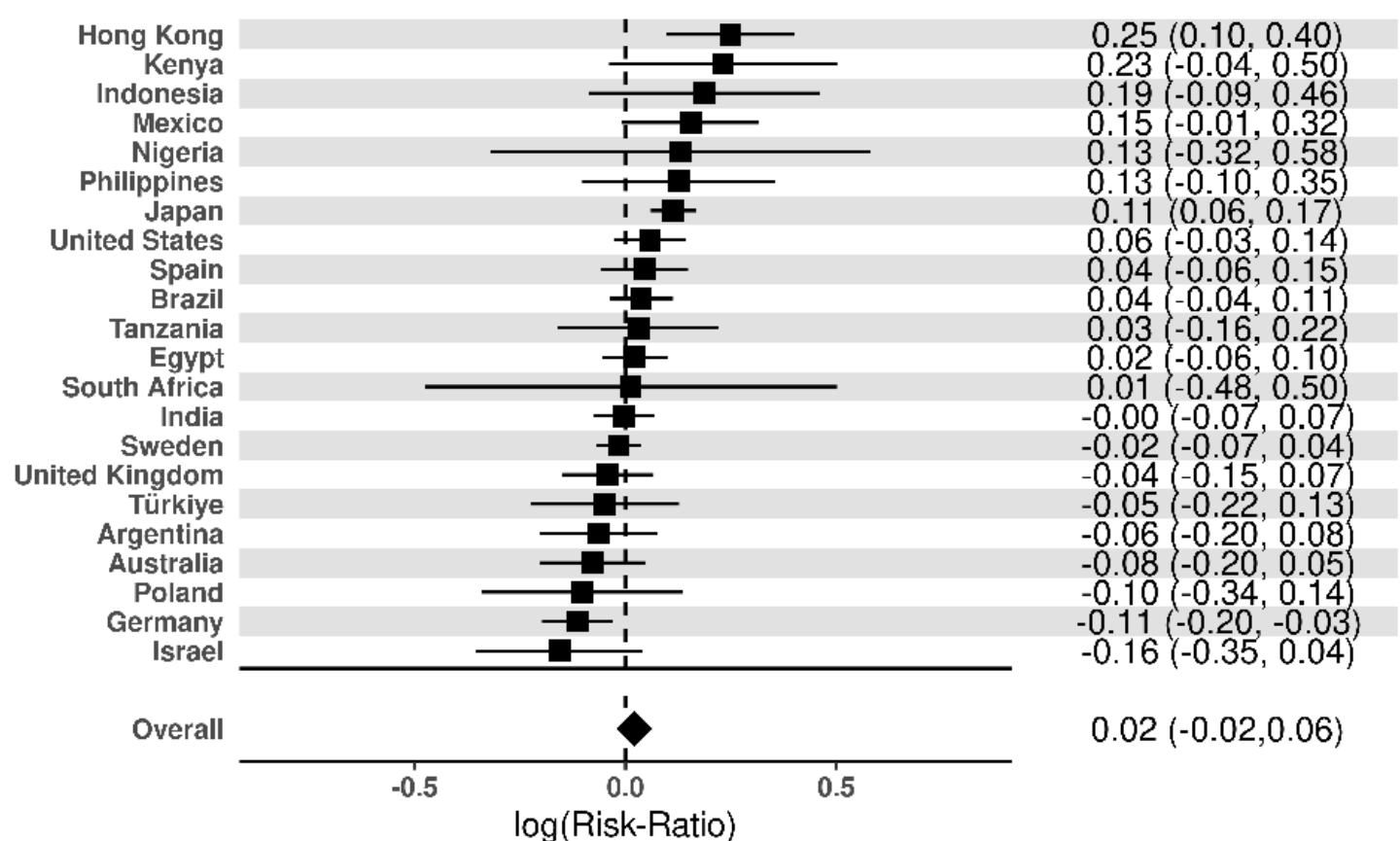

Figure S18. Forest plot for `Age 12 religious service attendance`-`<1/month` effect

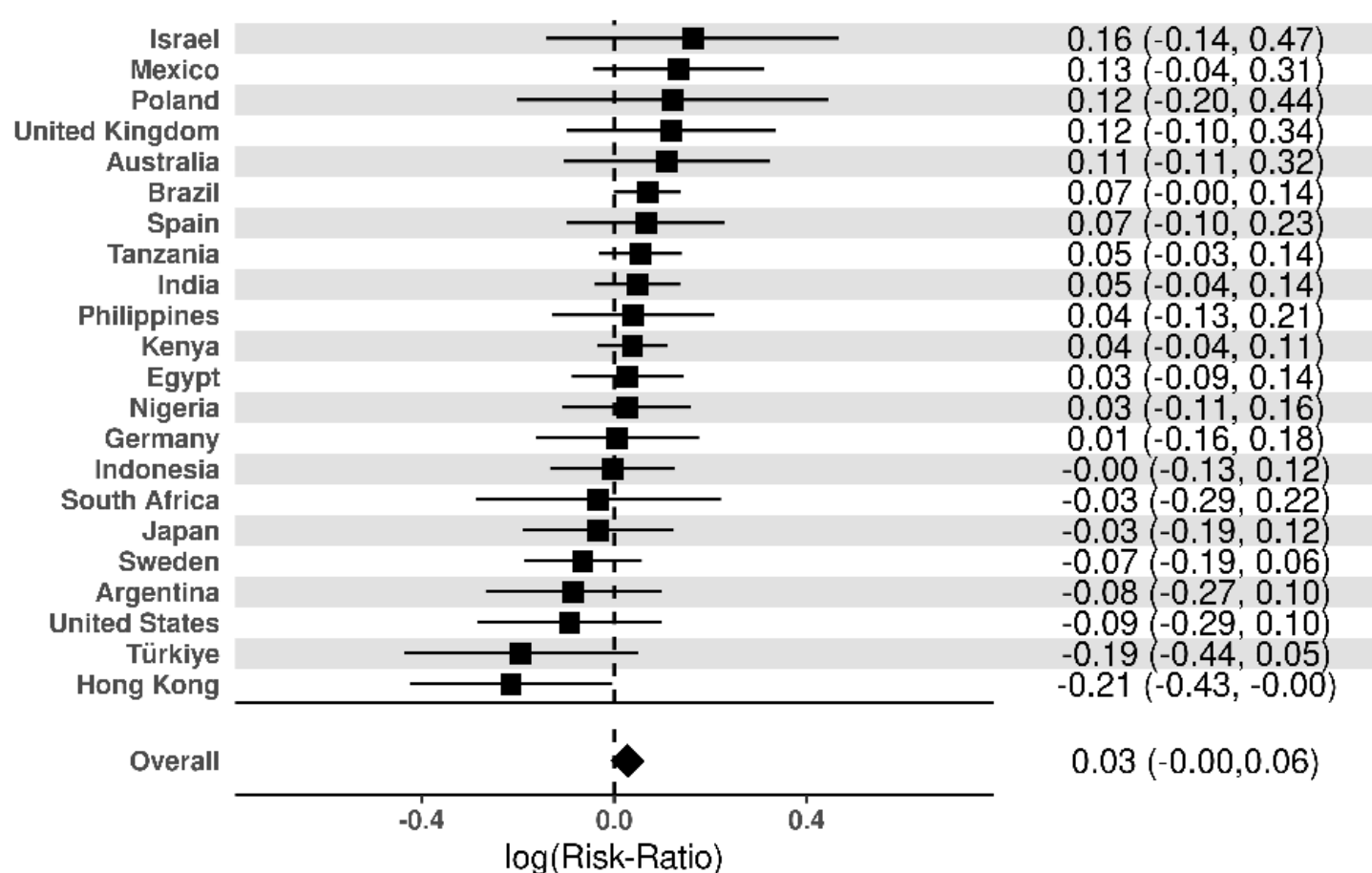

Figure S19. Forest plot for `Year of birth`-`1993-1998; age 25-29` effect

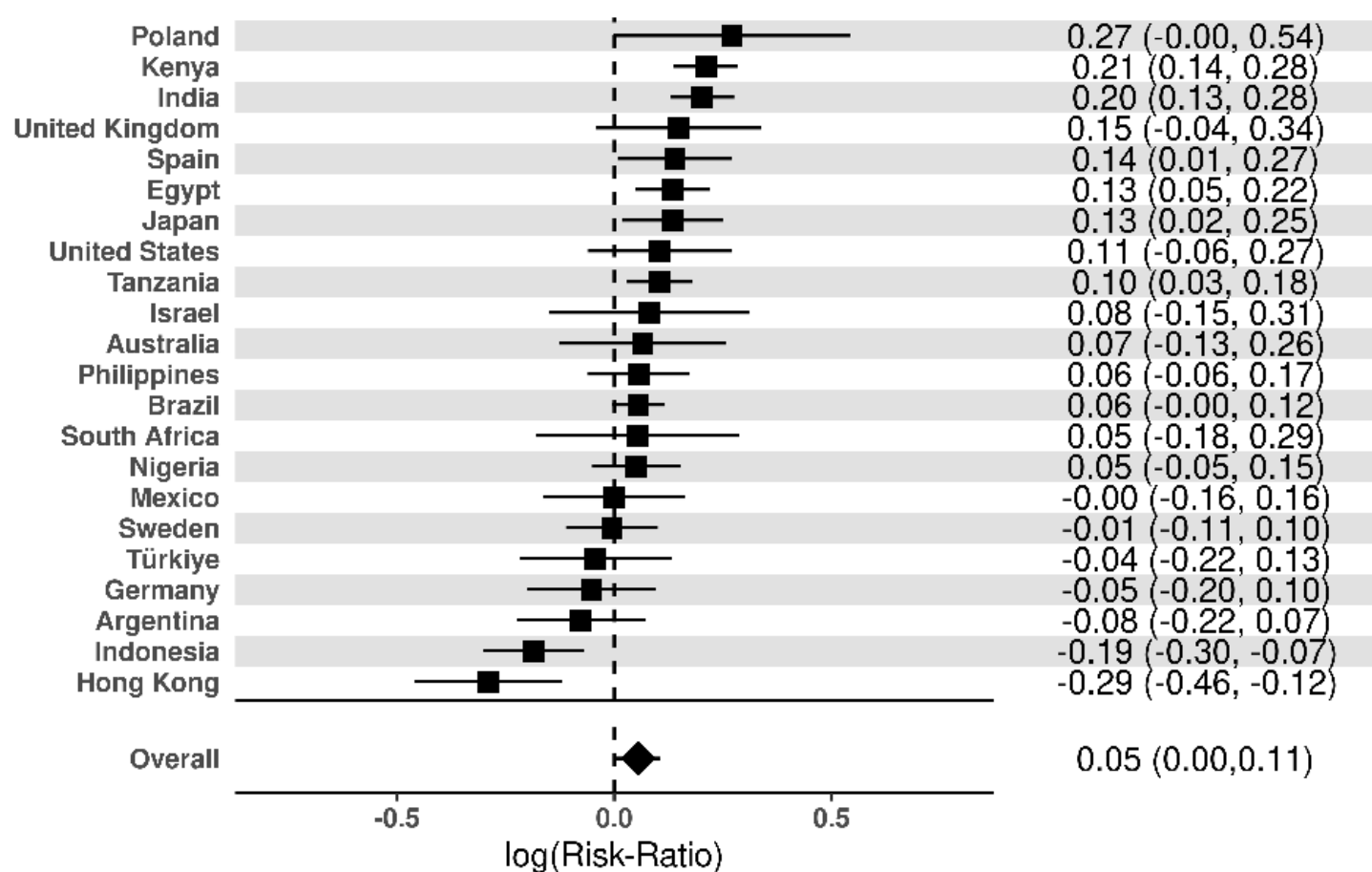

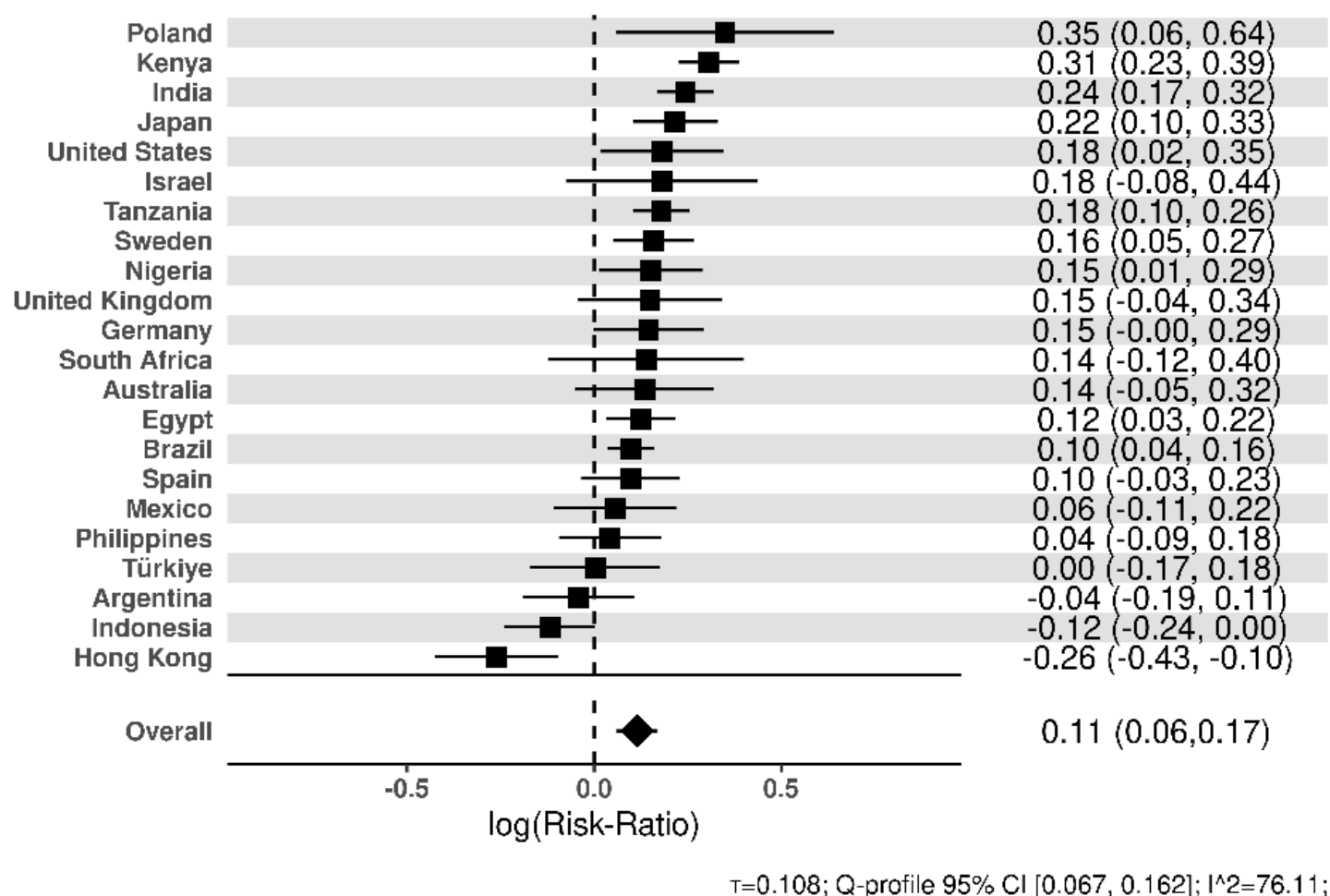


Figure S22. Forest plot for `Year of birth`-`1963-1973; age 50-59` effect

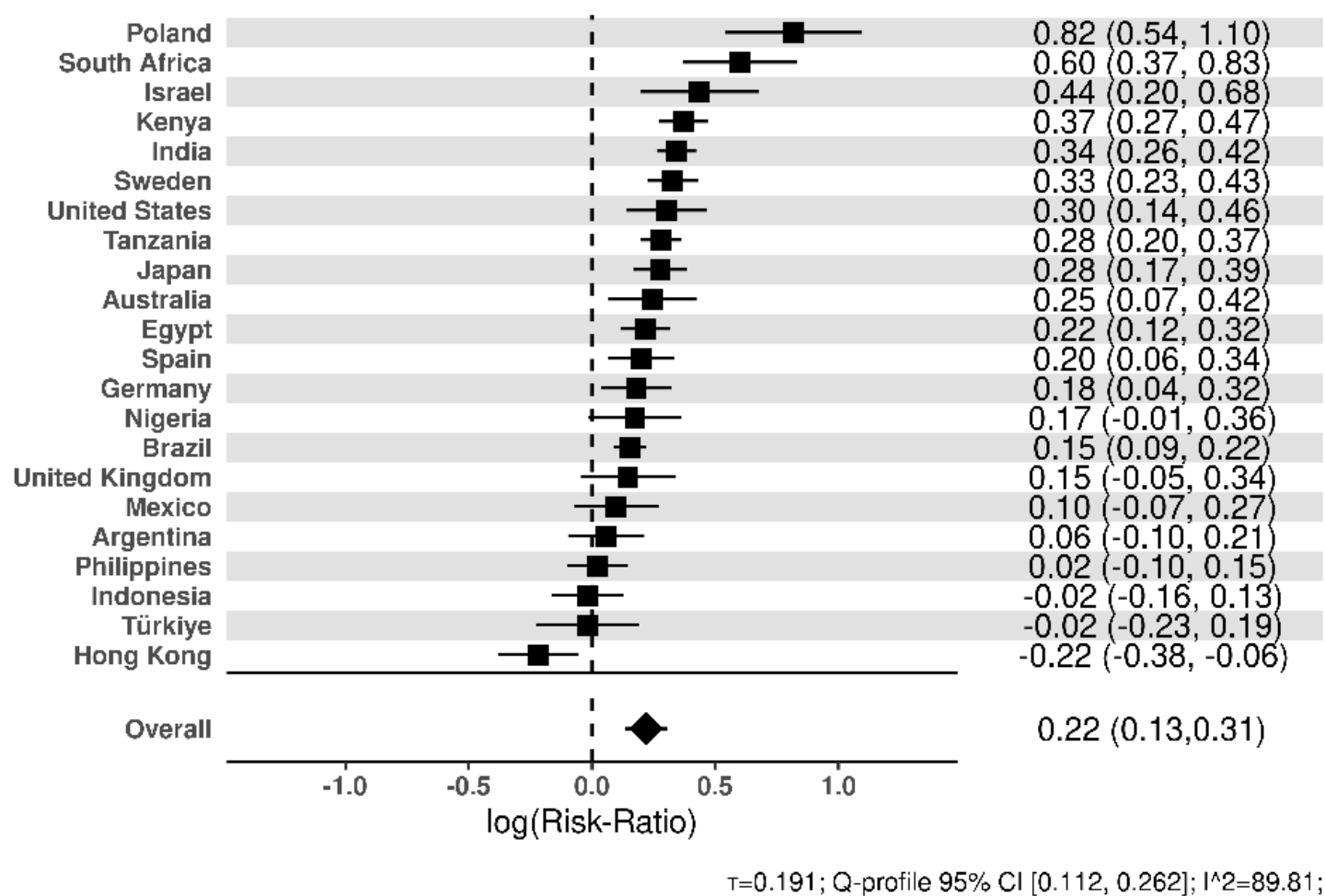


Figure S23. Forest plot for `Year of birth`-`1953-1963; age 60-69` effect

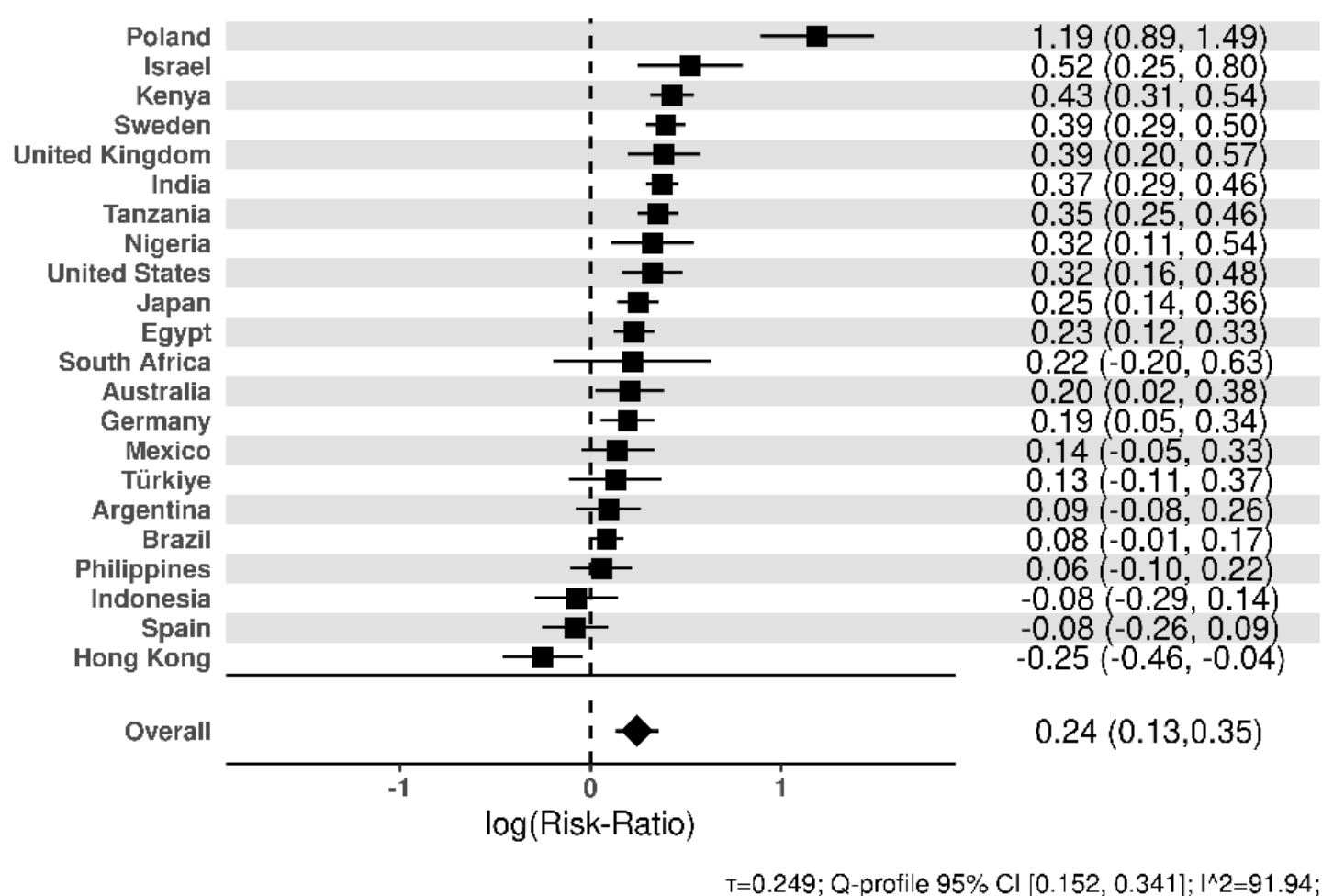


Figure S24. Forest plot for `Year of birth`-`1943-1953; age 70-79` effect

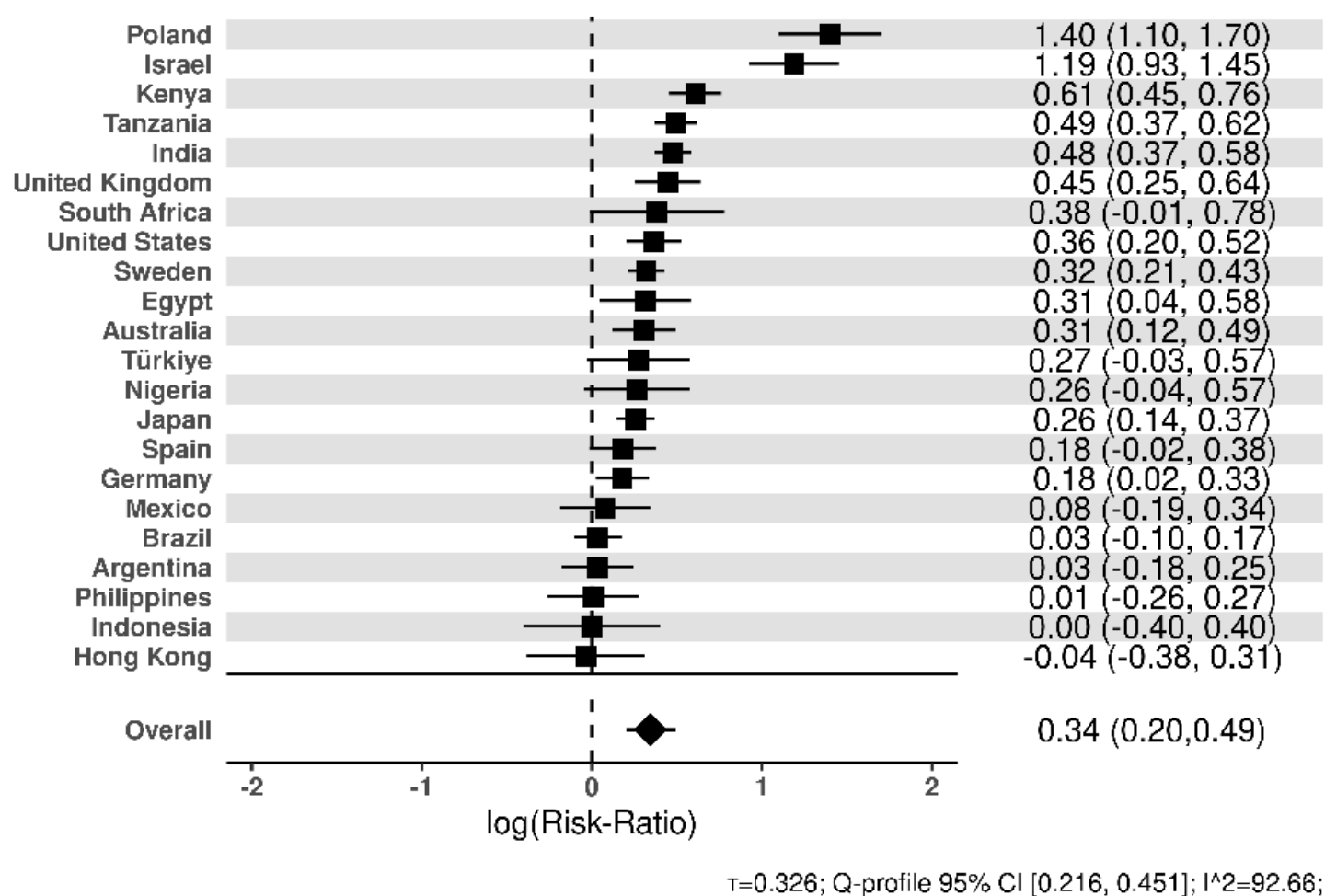


Figure S25. Forest plot for `Year of birth` - `1943 or earlier; age 80+` effect

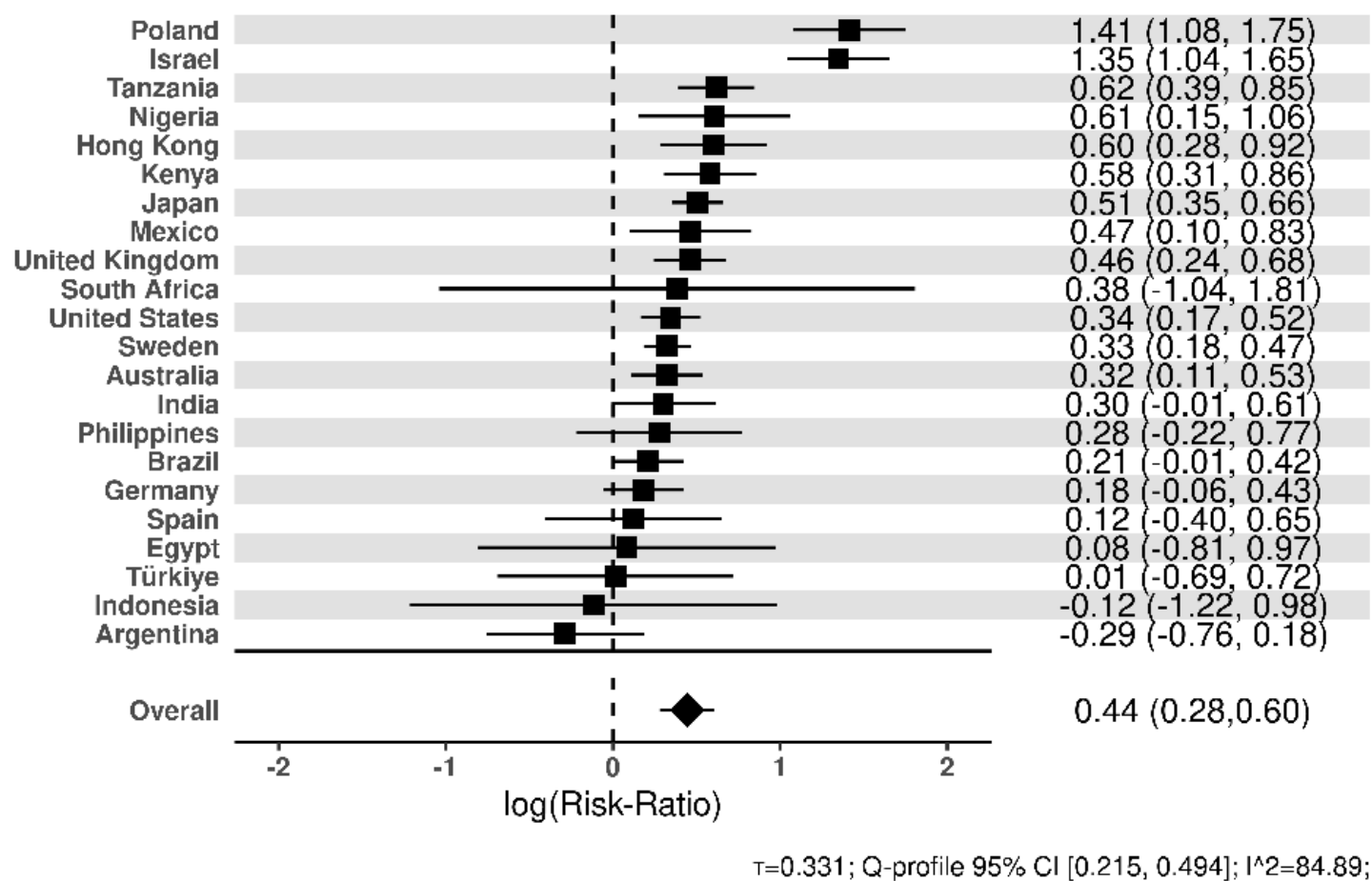


Figure S26. Forest plot for `Gender` - `Female` effect

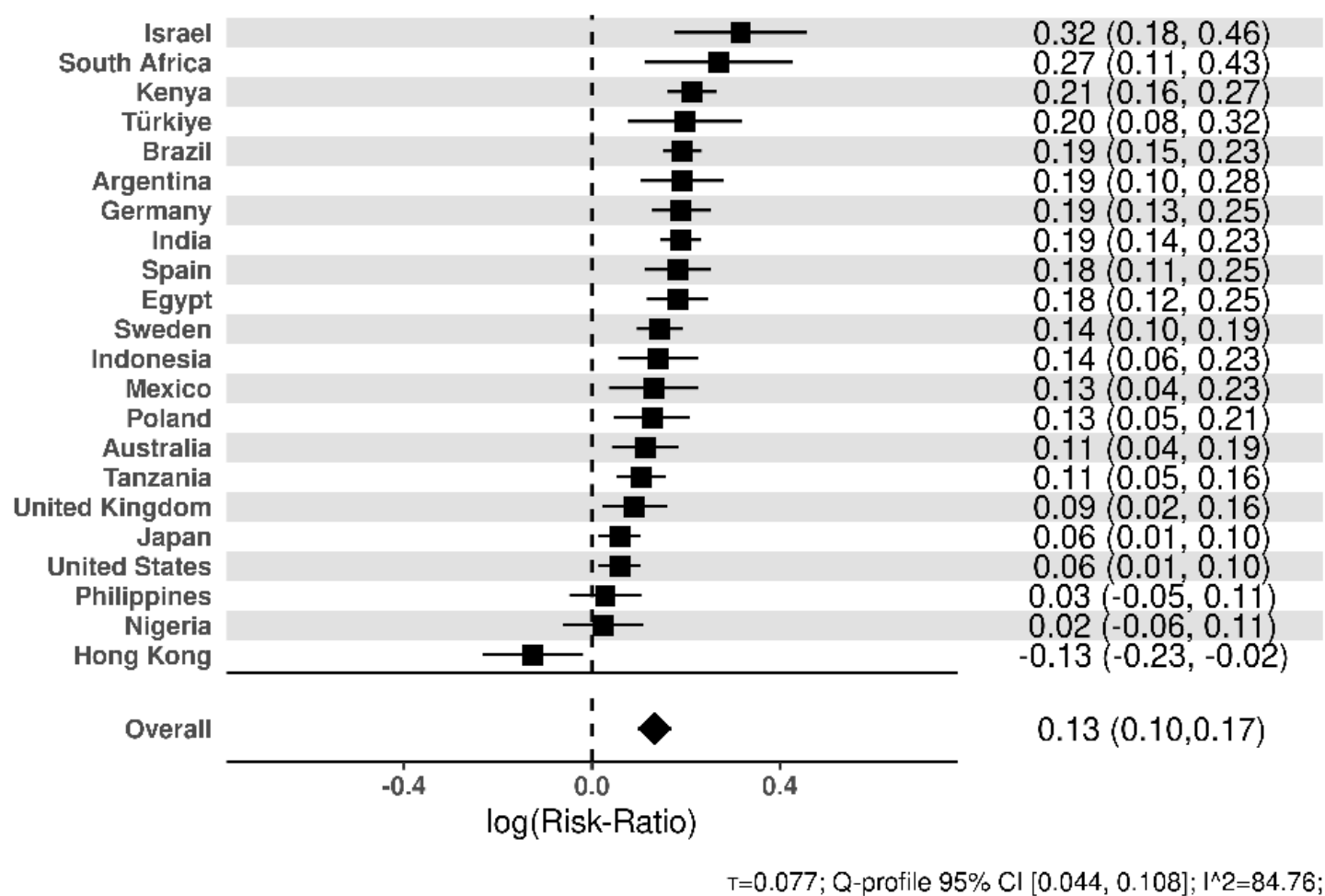
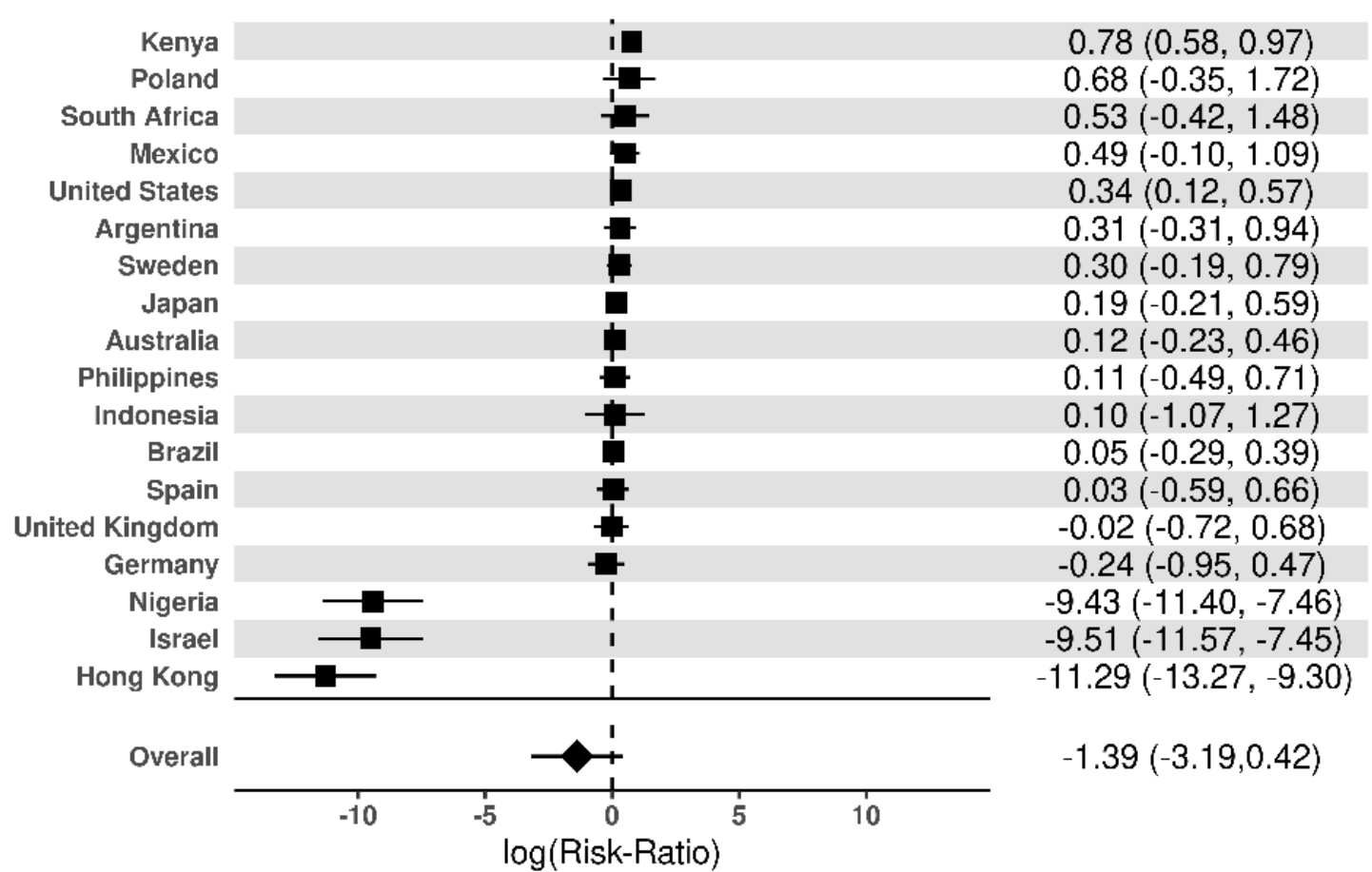


Figure S27. Forest plot for `Gender` - `Other` effect
