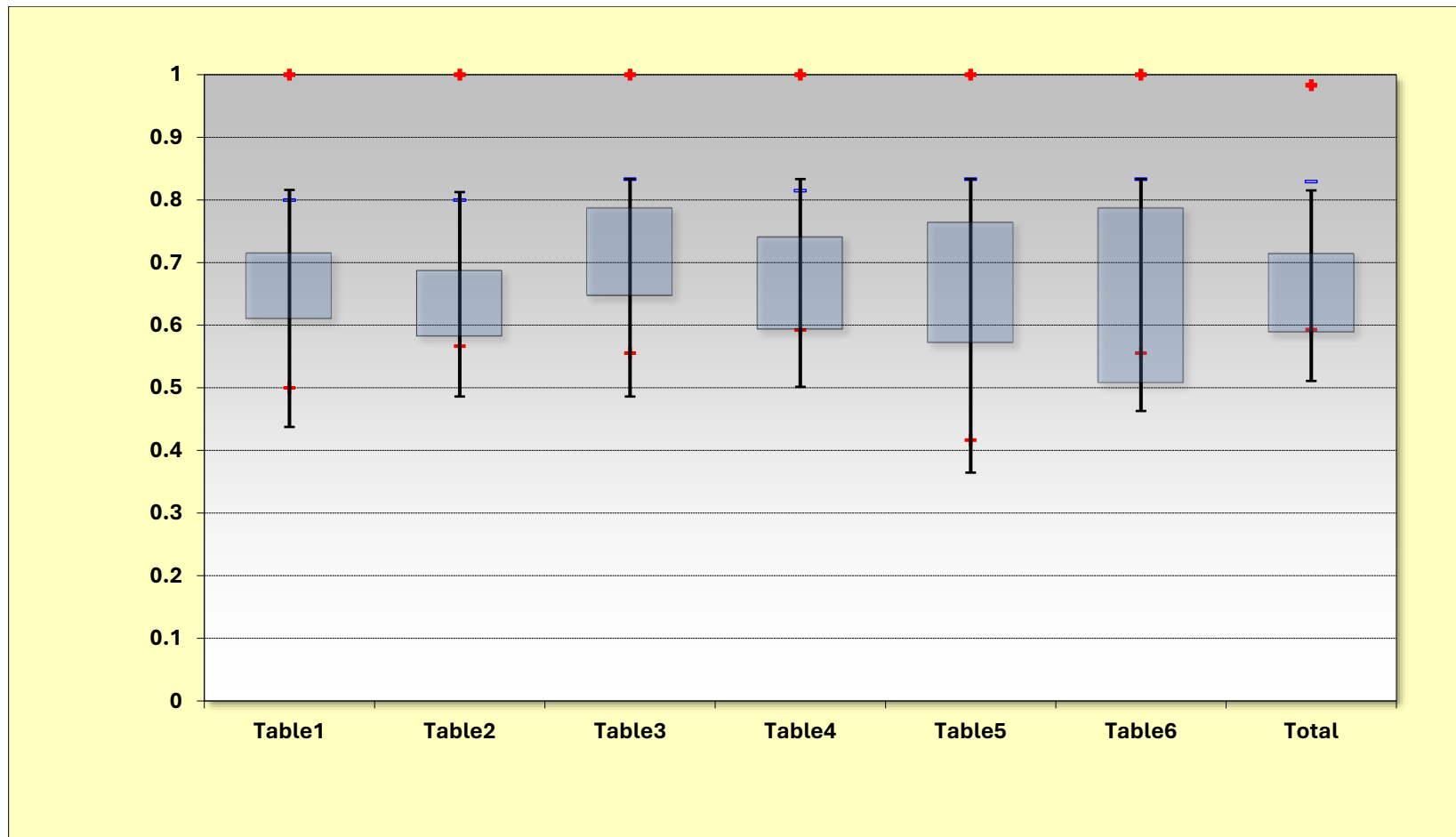


Figure 3 - Histogram of Tables 1 - 6 scores and the Total score

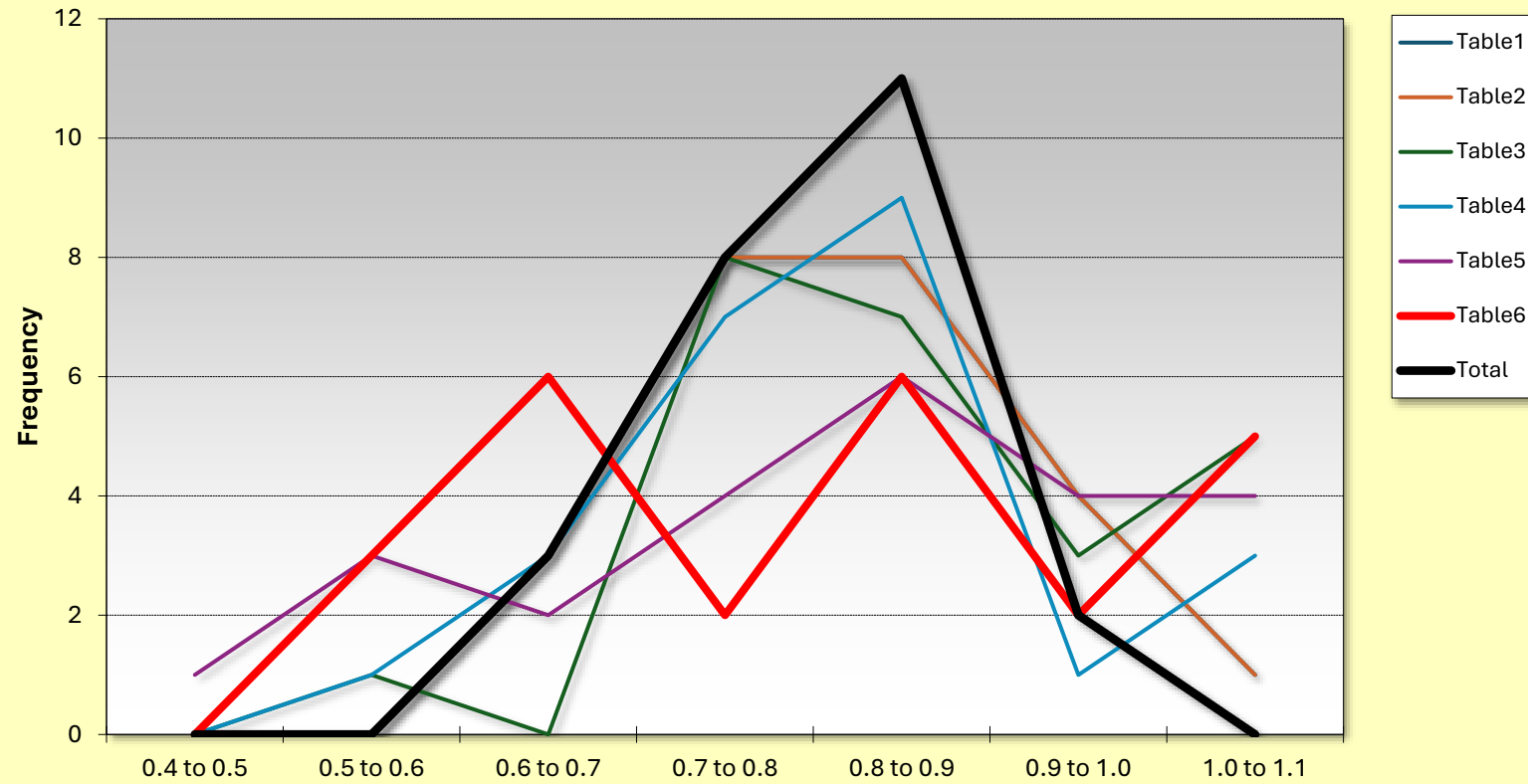


Figure 4 - Heat Map of Overall Scores
